PIKE COUNTY DOGWOOD FESTIVAL

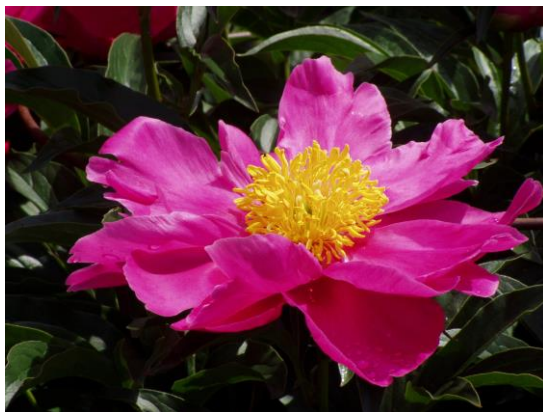
